Raising money to support children

Volunteers are needed to assist The Community Healing Centers' Roof Sit Sweeper Tournament, February 1 through the 13. The proceeds from this tournament help to support two programs that treat and prevent child abuse and neglect. Each night from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Roof Sit volunteers are needed to promote the tournament at the assigned Bowling houses. During this 2 hour shift, volunteers will encourage bowlers to donate \$2 to play in the sweeper tournament and earn the chance to be entered in a 5 Step Ladder Tournament as well prizes including two round trip tickets with Direct Air (trip to Ft. Myers). The volunteer job involves encouraging the nightly league bowlers to participate by donating \$2 to participate. Volunteer shifts are 2 hours from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Bowling experience not required.

Job Responsibilities:

- Your job will be to greet the league bowlers. We are asking them to donate \$2 to participate with the money going to support The Children's Advocacy Center and Parents as Partners. In 2009, the Sweeper Tournament raised \$3,700. We would like to beat that goal. It's simple to participate. The sheet is used to record their three game scores played as part of their league play. At the end of their league night play, they turn in the form to the Bowling Alley who retains all sheets for the Sweeper Tournament.
- You collect the \$2.00 and record paid on their sheet. You will be asked to provide a tally on how many sheets you distributed during your shift – this helps us track the dollars to the cards.
- Your job is to “talk-up” the event, the chance to win Direct Air round trip tickets, and the fact that they are making a donation to help treat and prevent child abuse here in SW Michigan.
- At the end of your shift, you will give the money to a staff person/runner who will be by to collect your items and money.
- During your shift you might be asked questions about Roof Sit – the materials will be there to provide assistance and any questions that can't be answered can be followed up by one of the staff members upon their return to the Bowling house. The table and equipment will be collected by the staff person
- As time permits, please remind bowlers that each bowling alley will have a top score women's bowler and top score men's bowler winner. Additional for every 50 bowlers, 1 bowler will advance to the tournament finals on February 27 at Richland Lanes. Each participating bowler will be entered in drawings for door prizes including free bowling equipment, area restaurant gift certificates, and limited edition t-shirts. Scoring is done based on individual participants score and includes the use of handicaps.
